**2019 Lenton Brae Margaret River Semillon Sauvignon Blanc**

This is a powerful, vibrant wine featuring abundant gooseberry and passionfruit aromas and flavours. The ripe flavours flow long on an acid-fresh palate. (\$24.00) ★★★★★

**2019 Hahndorf Hill White Mischief Adelaide Hills Grüner Veltliner**

Another impressive grüner veltliner from Hahndorf Hill. This one shows citrus characteristics with the familiar varietal peppery edge. The flavour persists and the palate has a good acid line. (\$24.00) ★★★★★☆

**2019 Symphony Hill Granite Belt Albariño**

An attractive wine with a distinctive floral perfume. The palate is “juicy”, textural and packed with varietal flavour supported by lively acidity. (\$65.00)

**2019 Moonrise Estate Granite Belt Pinot Gris**

Pale bronze colour. The apple/pear aromas and flavours express the variety well, and the palate offers textural appeal. (\$30.00) ★★★★★

**2019 Symphony Hill Granite Belt Gewürztraminer**

The classic rose petal, musk stick, spicy aromas are clearly evident. Strong varietal flavour and a touch of sweetness are balanced by acidity and measured phenolics. (\$45.00) ★★★★★

**2019 Hahndorf Hill Adelaide Hills Pinot Grigio**

The fresh pear juice nose, with a hint of floral, expresses the variety well. Good phenolic structure is a feature of a long, fresh palate. (\$25.00) ★★★★★

**2019 Two Rivers Hidden Hive Hunter Valley Verdelho**

A well made varietal style showing tropical fruit and citrus characteristics. Bright acidity lifts the finish. (\$16.00) ★★★★★

**2017 Twisted River Central Ranges Viognier**

A pleasingly textural style with clear-cut apricot and spice varietal character. Creamy, long and satisfying. (\$25.00) ★★★★★

**2018 Yarralaw Springs Southern Tablelands Chenin Blanc** The honeydew melon and citrus aromas have considerable appeal and the palate is acid-fresh. A very well made wine. (\$20.00) ★★★★★

**2018 Gibson Wines Discovery Road Fiano** This wine shows some tropical fruit elements with citrus overtones. The palate is well focused and textural. (\$25.00) ★★★★★

**2018 Yalumba Organic Pinot Grigio** Very fresh, with an attractive pear nose and good weight of fruit. The talc-like phenolics have considerable appeal. (\$22.00) ★★★★★

**2019 Risky Business King Valley Pinot Gris** This is a wine with delicate pear aromatics and a delightfully textural palate which is not too phenolic. Fresh acidity lifts the finish. (\$25.00) ★★★★★☆

**2019 Angullong Orange Region Pinot Grigio** The fresh, delicate pear aroma carries a hint of greenness and the palate is slightly sweet, with a fresh acid finish. (\$22.00) ★★★

**2019 Longview Queenie Adelaide Hills Pinot Grigio** This is a fresh young wine, but it's a little too green and herbal, lacking intensity. (\$21.00) ★★☆☆

**2018 Yalumba Organic Viognier** This lively wine is the epitome of viognier – apricot through and through – with appealing chalky phenolics. Excellent value for money. (\$22.00) ★★★★★

**2018 Mount Avoca Organic Estate Viognier** A full-on apricot style with significant initial impact. The palate is fresh, with positive textural grip. (\$32.50) ★★★★★

**2019 Singlefile Single Vineyard Mount Barker Fumé Blanc** A grapefruit/grassy style with an attractive touch of oak. The palate is long, textural and fresh. (\$35.00) ★★★★★

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
